Program Admissions Requirements:

- Students who have completed the general education core (42 hours), earned a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA, including a "C" in MATH 1324-Mathematics for Business and Social Sciences and satisfied TSI obligation may be admitted to the College of Humanities and Social Science.
- UHD will calculate the higher grade received on duplicate courses for GPA requirements.
- UHD will accept a "D" in courses except for MATH courses.

Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits:

- Credits from HCC that are transferrable to UHD degree programs may be specified in any program-to-program articulation agreement.
