- (3) PSYC 2301 will satisfy the Social Behavioral Science core requirement in the AAT degree at HCC. Students who take three (3) Life and Physical Science Core Courses, in different content areas (BIOL. CHEM. PHYS with a grade of C or higher) as part of the AAT may transfer the third course in for NS 3310.

Program Admissions Requirements:

- Students who have completed the general education core (42 hours), earned a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA, including a “C” in MATH 1324-Mathematics for Business and Social Sciences and satisfied TSI obligation may be admitted to the College of Public Service.
- UHD will calculate the higher grade received on duplicate courses for GPA requirements.
- UHD will accept a “D” in courses except for MATH courses.

Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits:

- Credits from HCC that are transferrable to UHD degree programs may be specified in any program-to-program articulation agreement.
- Reverse transfer
- HCC students will be allowed access to academic advising services at UHD
- HCC Honors students admitted to UHD will receive:
 - Acceptance to UHD Honors Program with a minimum GPA (GPA varies by the College in which the program resides)
 - UHD will accept a minimum of 12 hours of transfer Honors credit; eligible for merit and need-based aid commensurate with qualifications
