- (2) PHYS 2325 will satisfy the Physical Lab Science elective in the AAT degree at HCC. This elective will transfer and apply to degree requirements at UHD.
- (3) PSYC 2301 will satisfy the Social Behavioral Science core requirement in the AAT degree at HCC.
- (4) Students who take three (3) Life and Physical Science Core Courses, in different content areas (BIOL. CHEM. PHYS with a grade of C or higher) as part of the AAT may transfer the third course in for NS 3310.

Program Admissions Requirements:

- Students who have completed the general education core (42 hours), earned a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA, including a "C" in MATH 1324-Mathematics for Business and Social Sciences and satisfied TSI obligation may be admitted to the College of Humanities and Social Science.
- UHD will calculate the higher grade received on duplicate courses for GPA requirements.
- UHD will accept a "D" in courses except for MATH courses.

Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits:

- Credits from HCC that are transferrable to UHD degree programs may be specified in any program-to-program articulation agreement.
- Reverse transfer
- HCC students will be allowed access to academic advising services at UHD
- HCC Honors students admitted to UHD will receive:
 - Acceptance to UHD Honors Program with a minimum GPA (GPA varies by the College in which the program resides)
 - UHD will accept a minimum of 12 hours of transfer Honors credit; eligible for merit and need-based aid commensurate with qualifications
