(1) Nursing Prerequisites: ENGL 1301, BIOL 2401 & completion of MATH 0309, MATH 0310 or college level math course with a “C” or higher is required prior to applying to the LSC Nursing Program.

MATH 1342 is required for completion of the BSN at UHD. Completion of Statistics (MATH 1342) at LSC will allow the student to choose an elective at UHD. Student should consult with an advisor regarding math assessment testing to determine the appropriate math course.

**Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits:**

- Reverse transfer
- Credits from LSC that are transferrable to UHD degree programs may be specified in any program-to-program articulation agreement.
- LSC students will be allowed access to academic advising services at UHD
- LSC Honors students admitted to UHD will receive:
  - Acceptance to UHD Honors Program with a minimum GPA (GPA varies by the College in which the program resides)
  - UHD will accept a minimum of 12 hours of transfer Honors credit; eligible for merit and need-based aid commensurate with qualifications
