# **The Senate Serves**

- The Faculty Assembly: All UHD employees holding academic rank as full-time faculty
- 254 fulltime tenured/tenure-track faculty
- 96 lecturer faculty
- Over 400 adjunct faculty
- The UHD student body of approximately 15,000 students



**SENATE MEMBERSHIP** consists of the president, president-elect, past president, and senate secretary plus elected representatives from all four colleges and their academic departments.


- •The current senate seats 32 senators and four senate officers
- The full senate meets every 1st and 3rd Tuesday each month during fall and spring
  A quorum equals 60% of the total senate membership
- •All members of the faculty assembly may attend and participate in discussions at the regular senate meetings, but only senators may propose motions and vote

# **Terms of Office**

- Senators serve two-year terms.
- Terms overlap for each department.
- No senator serves more than two consecutive terms.
- Terms of office run from August 15 to August 14.
- Senators can't miss more than two meetings per semester and attend meetings twice via zoom.



- If a senator misses three meetings in a semester the senate president will notify the senator's department chair.
- Each college is eligible to elect tenured/tenure-track faculty as well as one lecturer and/or clinical faculty to serve as their representative.
- Tenure-track nominees must be members of the faculty assembly for at least six long semesters prior to serving (i.e., going into their 4<sup>th</sup> year).
- No department will have more than one member on any senate standing committee



The senate meets with university and system leaders, public officials, staff council, student government, and others to discuss issues of general interest to faculty, students, staff and the community.

Senate meetings are conducted according to:

- Roberts Rules of Order
- The UHD Constitution, policies, bylaws, and resolutions

## **Senate Standing Committees**

The senate has two standing committees: FSEC and CCE



#### 1. Faculty Senate Executive Committee (FSEC)

- FSEC consists of the president, president-elect, past president, secretary and three members-at-large elected by the Senate.
- FSEC at-large members elected by the Senate represent each academic college and serve one-year terms.
- FSEC prepares and distributes the agenda prior to each senate meeting.
- FSEC represents the Senate on routine business and drafts resolutions for policies and procedures.
- FSEC receives and files committee reports.

#### 2. Committee on Credentials and Elections (CCE)

 CCE consists of the senate president-elect who also chairs the committee, and one member from each college academic department.



- Members serve two-year overlapping terms.
- CCE nominates and conducts the election of faculty senate officers, senators and committee members.
- CCE conducts elections by secure and anonymous balloting process.
- CCE investigates and reports to the Senate all questions pertaining to elections.
- CCE decides eligibility for senate membership and other elected committee positions.
- CCE establishes all election guidelines.
- CCE ensures that no more than three nominees are on the ballot for any one position presented for a vote.

# **Elections**

- Each Spring the senate performs faculty elections to represent each college.
- Elections are conducted among voting T/TT faculty and lecturers in accordance with the bylaws, shared governance policies, and the UHD Constitution.
- Special elections are required to fill senate and committee vacancies.

## **Faculty Work Climate Survey**


#### Preliminary Report

- Recognition of Faculty Years of Service














The senate appoints two faculty members to serve on a Commencement Speaker Selection Committee and plans logistics for commencement speakers.




### **Texas Council of Faculty Senates**

## Faculty Senate Executive Council (FSEC)

- The Executive Committee shall consist of the presidentelect, the president, the immediate past president, the secretary and four senate members-at-large elected by the Senate.
- The at-large members elected by the Senate shall serve oneyear terms but may be reelected.
  - In electing the members-at-large, the Senate should strive for representation across all academic colleges.
- One at-large seat is held for a lecturer.
  - If no lecturer volunteers, this seat can be held by a T/TT faculty member.

## Faculty Senate Executive Council (FSEC)

- Prepare and distribute an agenda prior to each Senate meeting
- Act for the Senate on routine business and in the implementation of policies and procedures
- Receive and file all committee reports
- Meet with University leadership to discuss issues of general interest to the faculty and institution
- Nominate and appoint faculty members to serve on university and/or UH- System committees or task forces whenever the Committee on Credentials and Elections is not available to make nominations, and the Faculty Senate is not available to appoint representatives.
- FSEC meetings are held in weeks that Senate does not meet (inperson). Date/Time for FSEC meetings to be communicated once at-large members are elected.
