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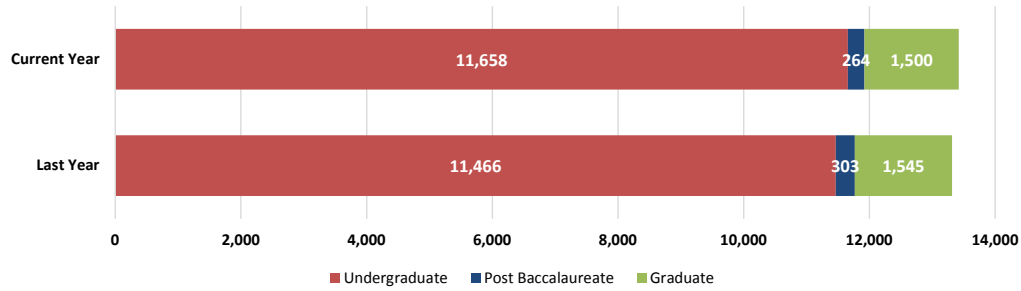
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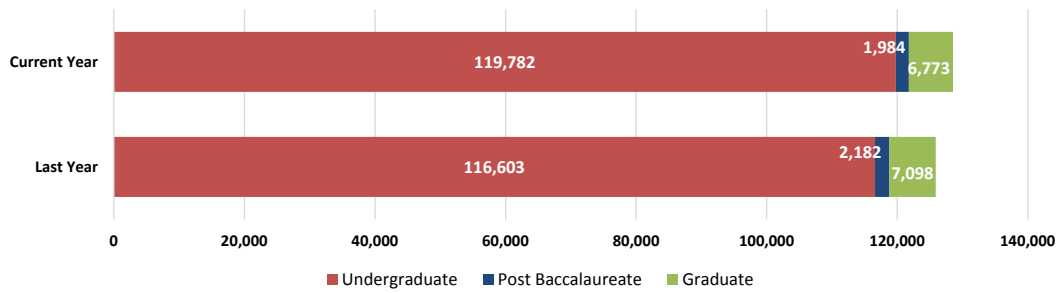
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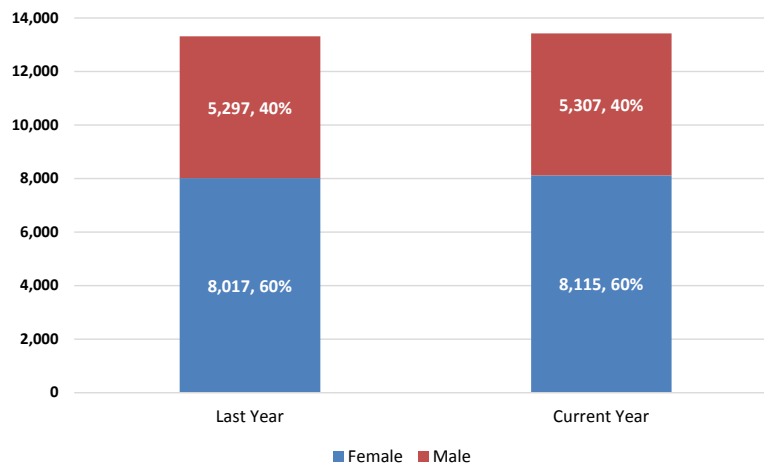
Headcount by Year and Student Type



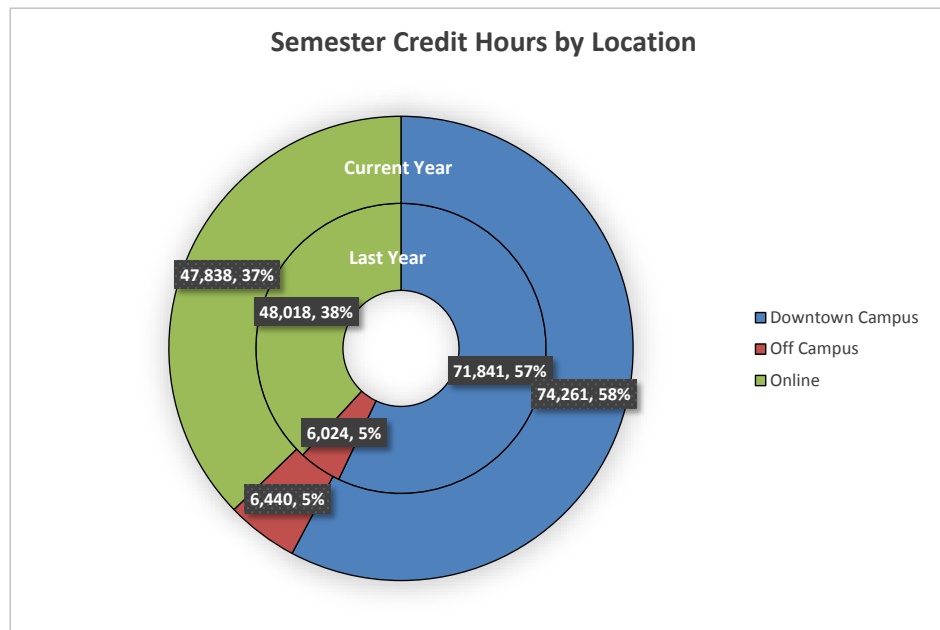
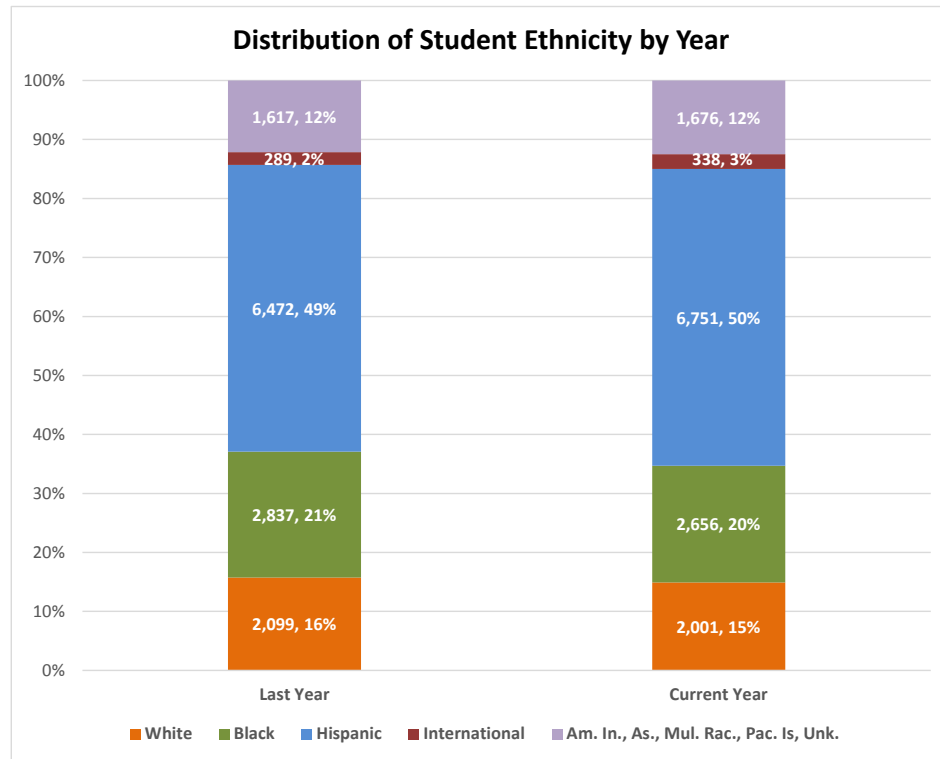
Semester Credit Hours by Year and Student Type



Overall Gender Distribution

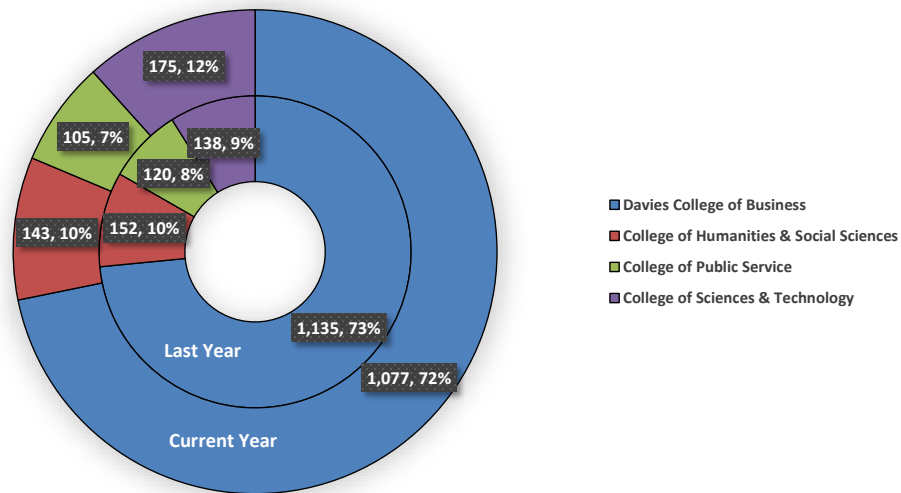


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Distribution of Graduate Program Counts by College
