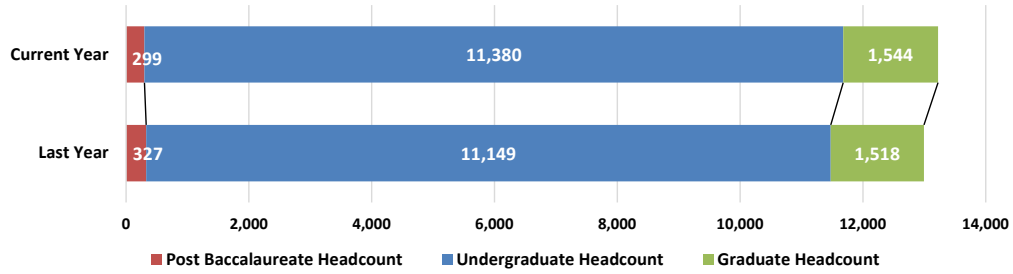
Beginning Fall 2016, UHD implemented a policy that allows new students to declare their major upon admission to the University, if eligible. 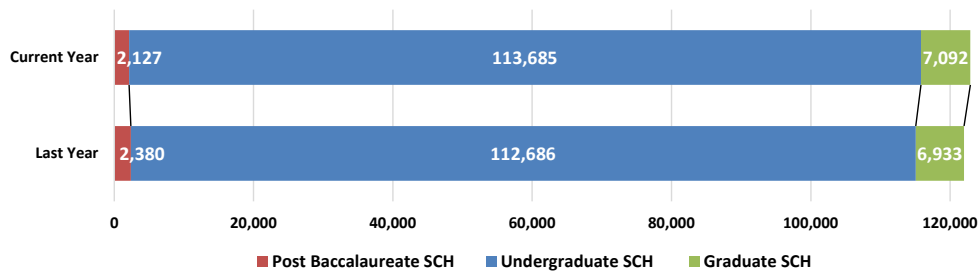

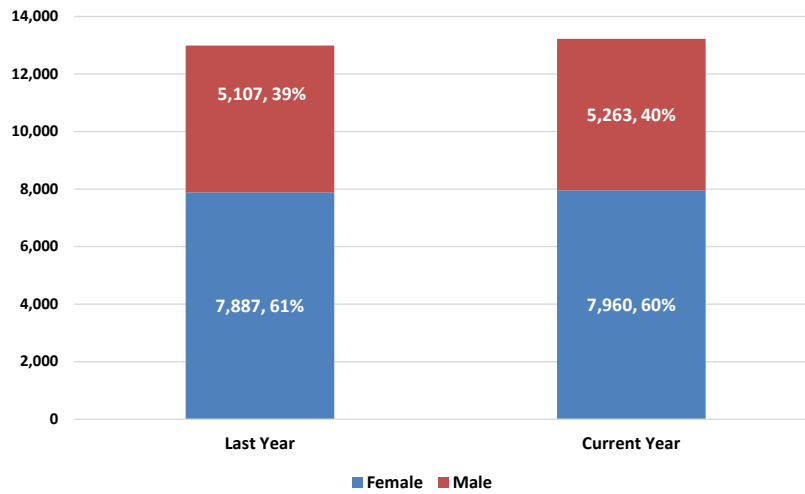
Headcount by Year and Student Type



Semester Credit Hours by Year and Student Type

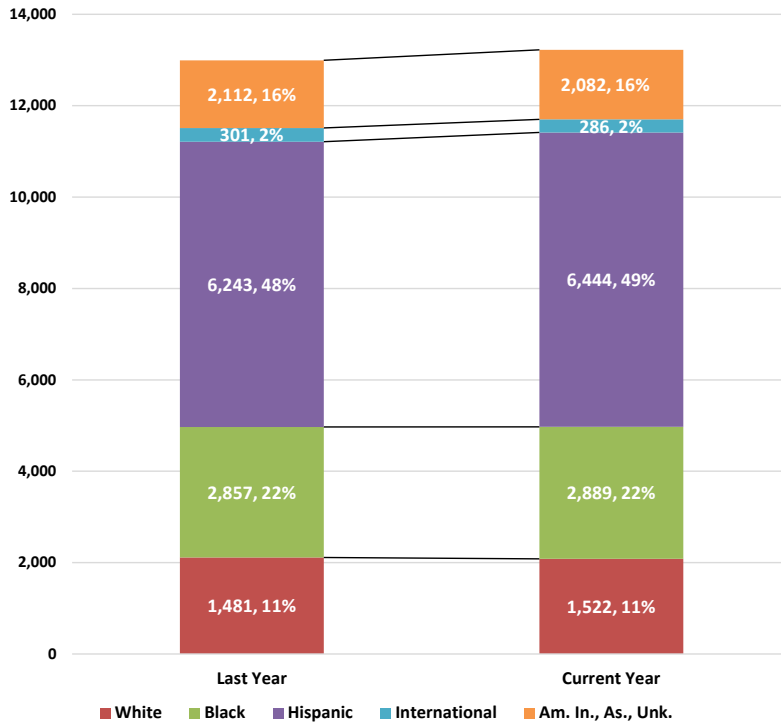


Overall Gender Distribution

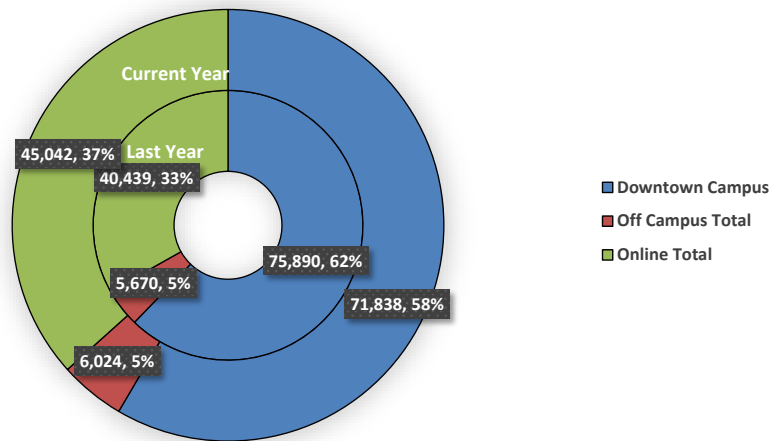

Distribution of Student Race/Ethnicity by Year

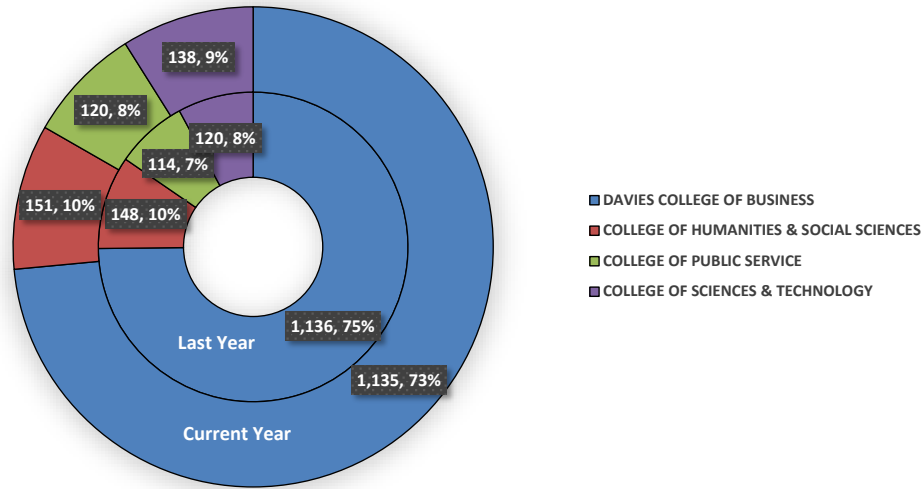


Semester Credit Hours by Location
