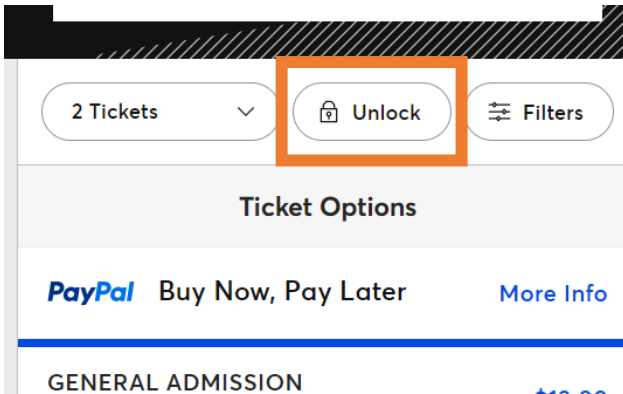


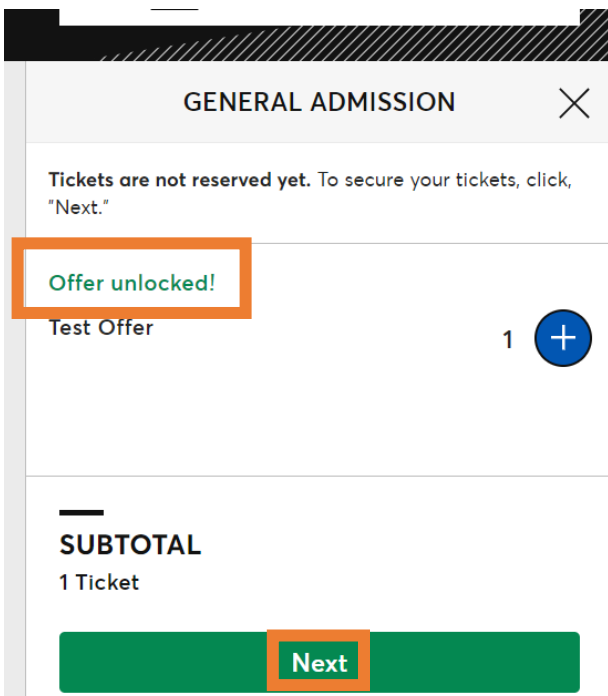
How to Buy Tickets on Ticketmaster.com

Buying tickets on Ticketmaster.com is simple! For General Admission events, there are no assigned seats. Therefore, you will not see a map on the event page. Please follow the steps below to use your Student ID to reserve your tickets.

When you are on the event page, make sure to enter your **STUDENT ID** into the **UNLOCK** box on the right side of the page.

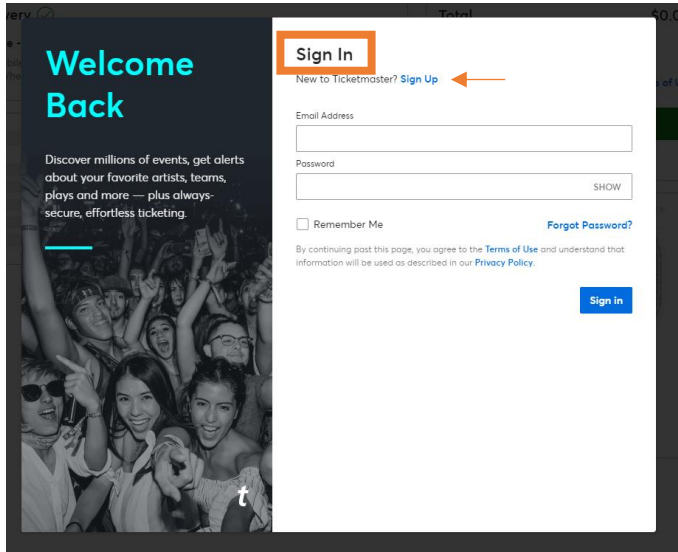


Once your ID has been accepted, you will see that you have unlocked the tickets. Use the **+** or **-** to adjust the number of tickets you would like to reserve.

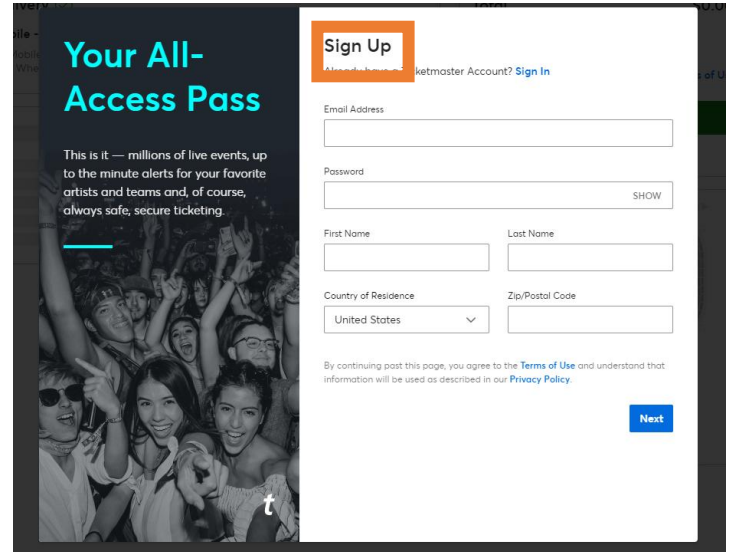


Select the number of tickets you would like to reserve and hit **NEXT**.

Once you click next, you can either **SIGN IN** to Ticketmaster if you already have an existing account, or you can **SIGN UP** for one right there!

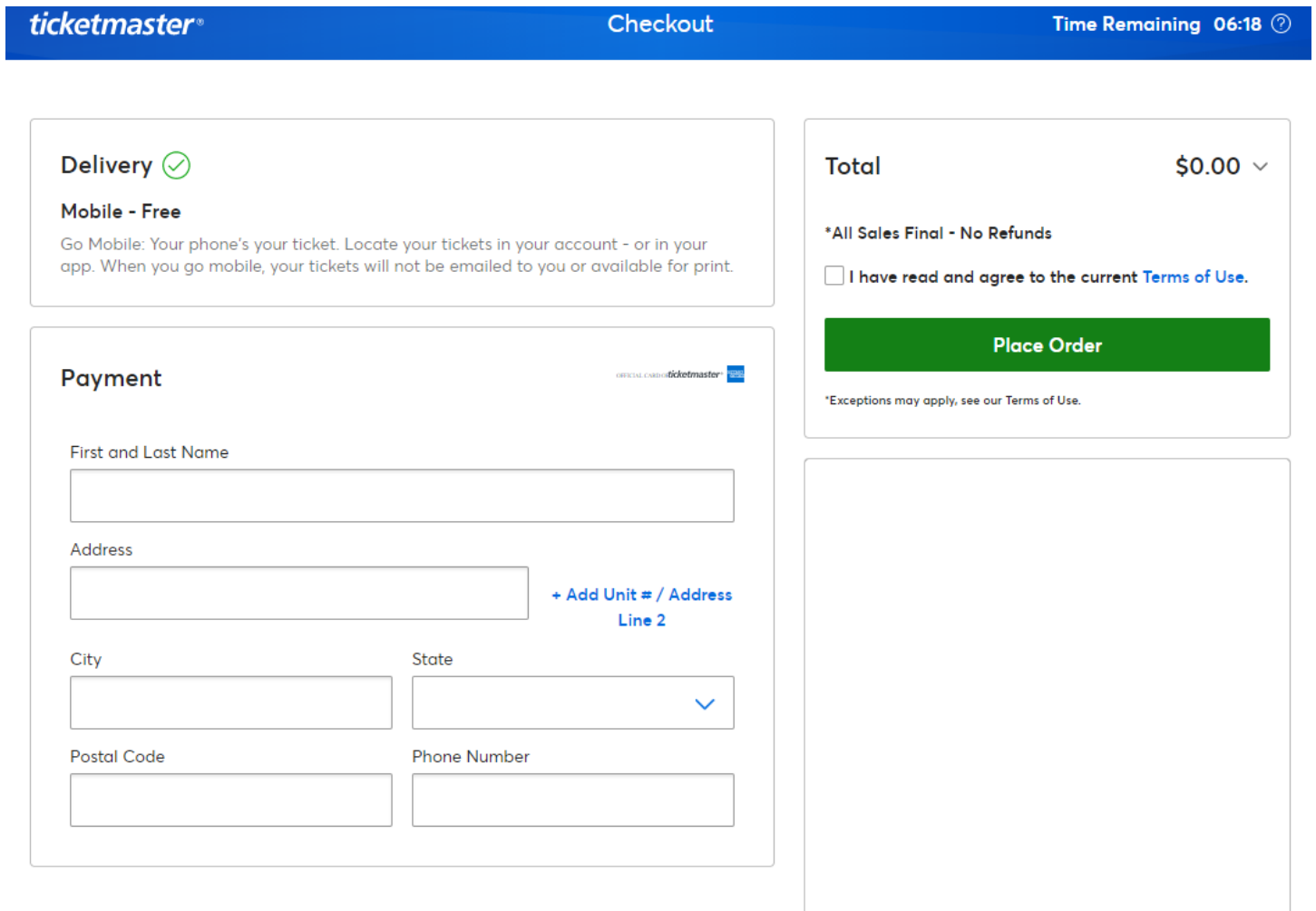

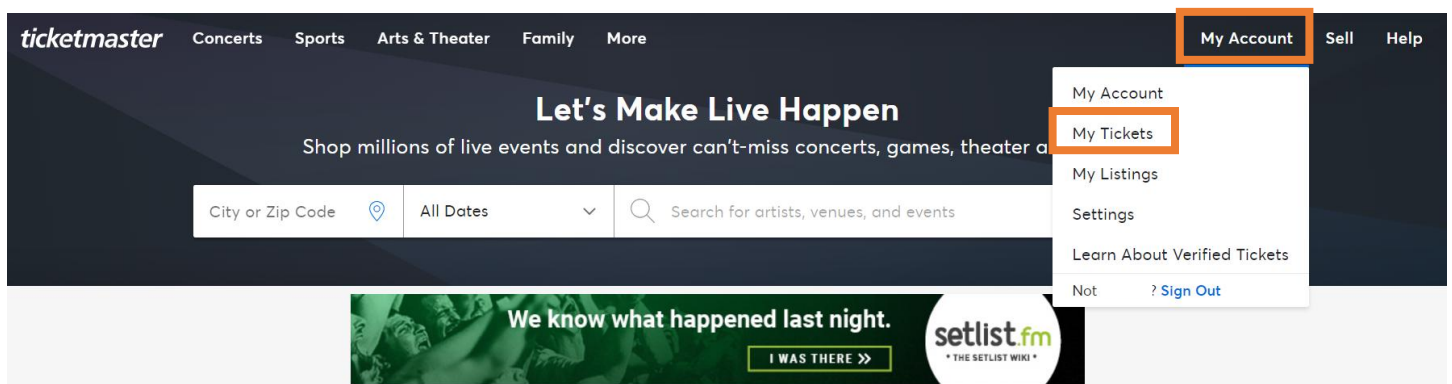

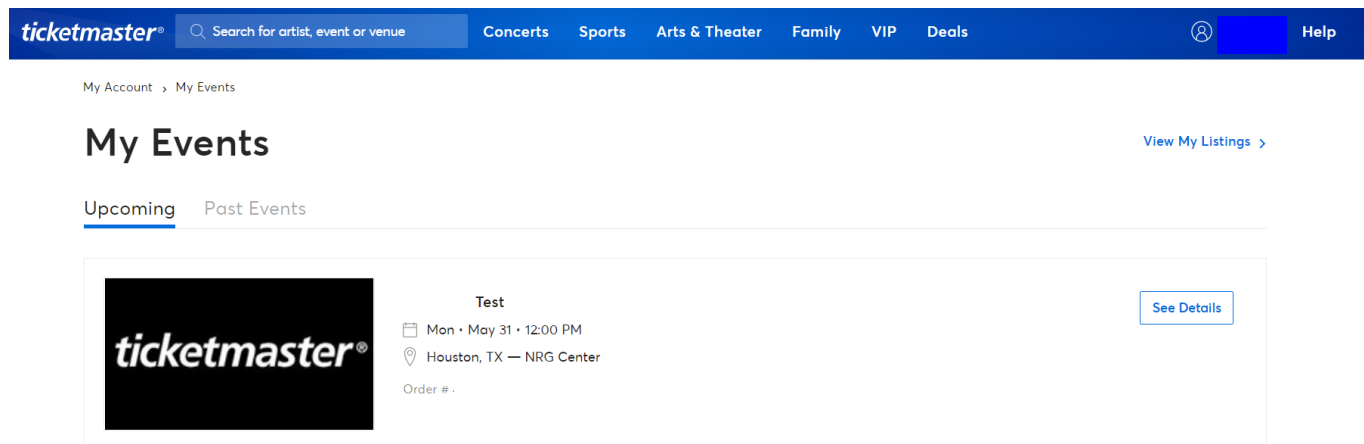
Go to www.ticketmaster.com and sign in to your account with your email address and password. If you need to reset your password, select **FORGOT PASSWORD?**

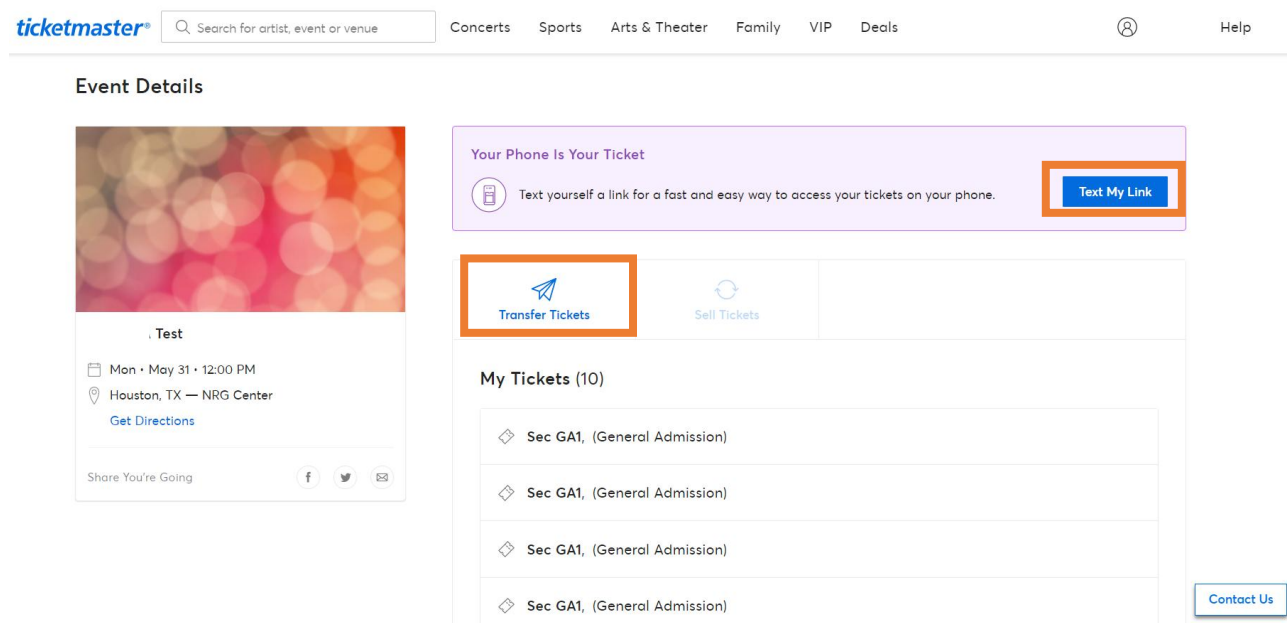

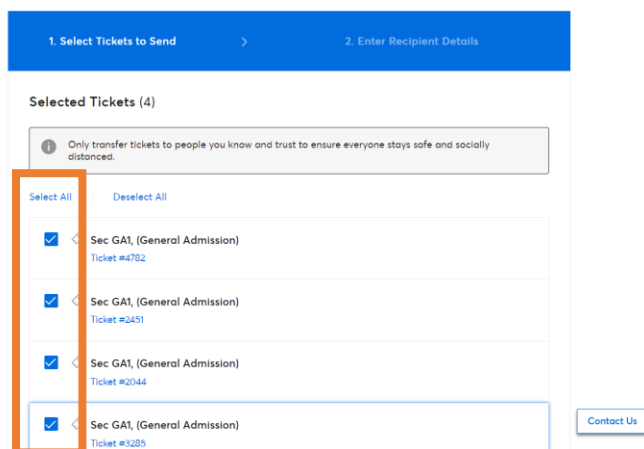

Once you have sent the tickets, the person receiving the tickets **MUST CLAIM AND ACCEPT** the tickets. This can be done by clicking on the email sent to them via Ticketmaster to accept their tickets. They must login with their Ticketmaster account or create one to accept the tickets. After the person has logged in, they can accept the tickets to their account, and you will receive a notification once this has been completed. The receiver can then login and view the transferred tickets.

*Please note, the only way to transfer tickets on Ticektmaster.com is via email. Download and login to the Ticketmaster app on your smartphone to transfer tickets via text/cell phone number.
