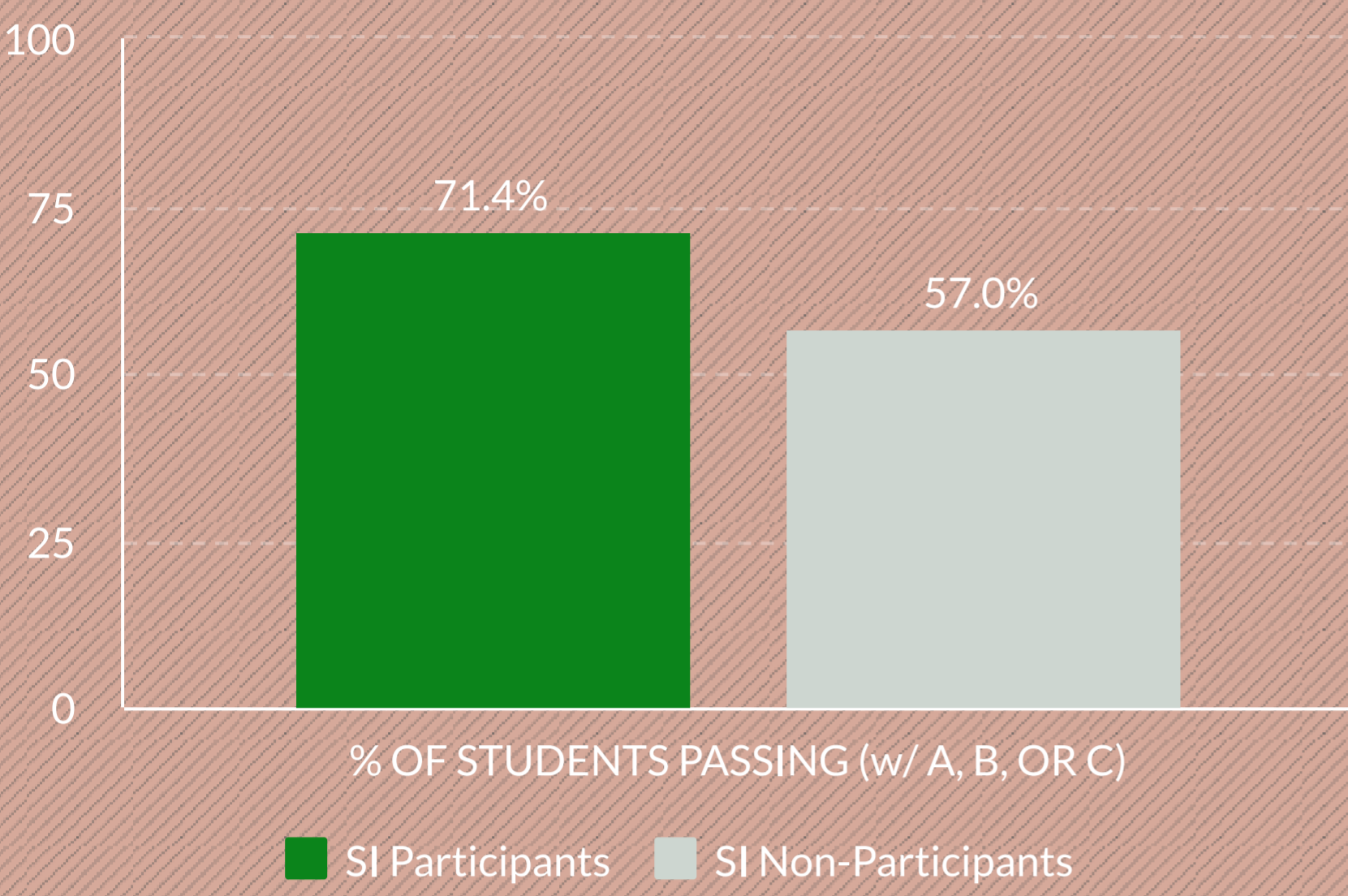


UHD SUPPLEMENTAL INSTRUCTION PROGRAM DATA FALL 2019

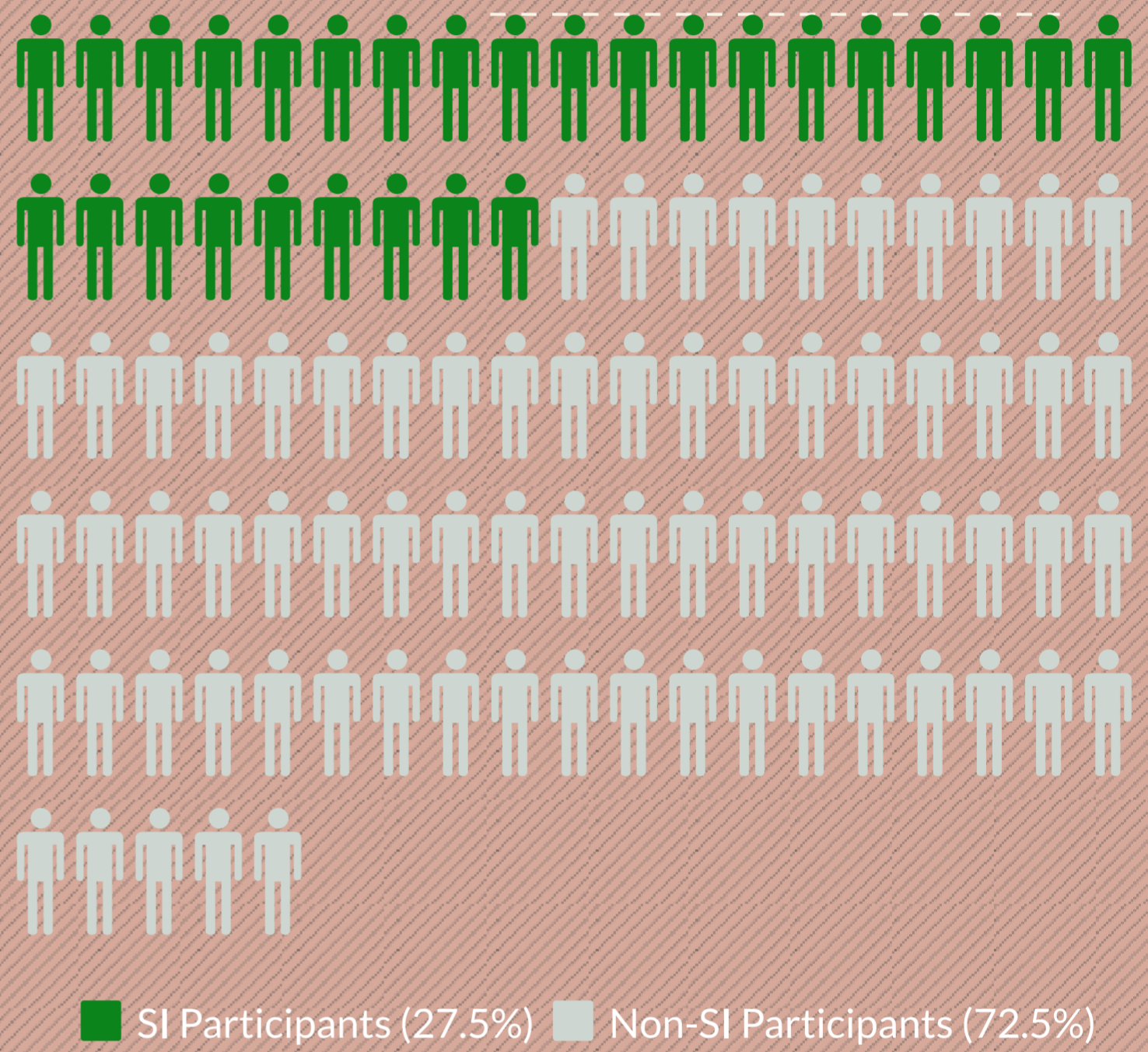
OVERVIEW



In Fall 2019, the University of Houston-Downtown SI Program offered over 1,600 sessions with an average of 3 students attending per session.

Across all sections, 68.8% of students who attended SI came to sessions more than once.

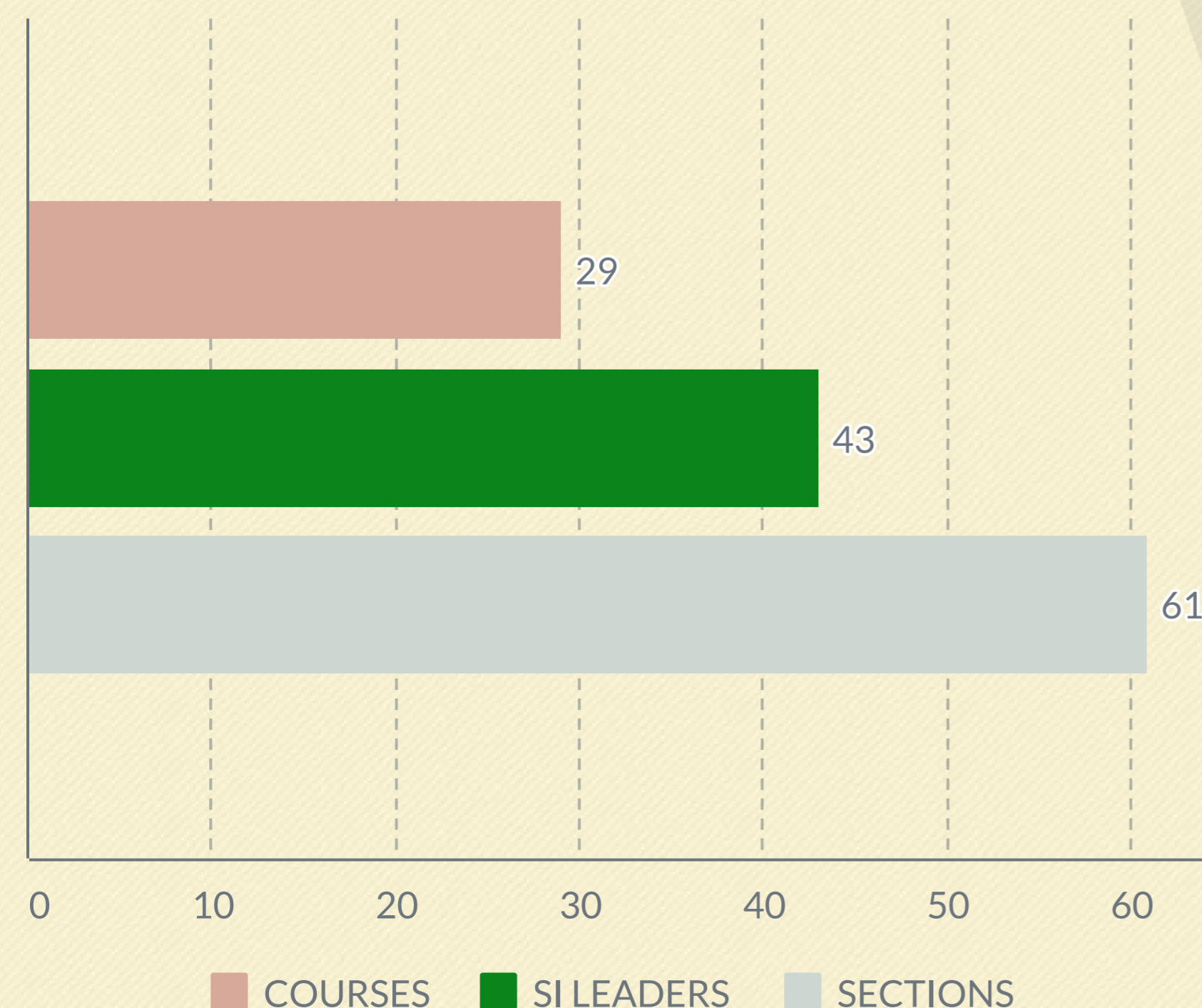
