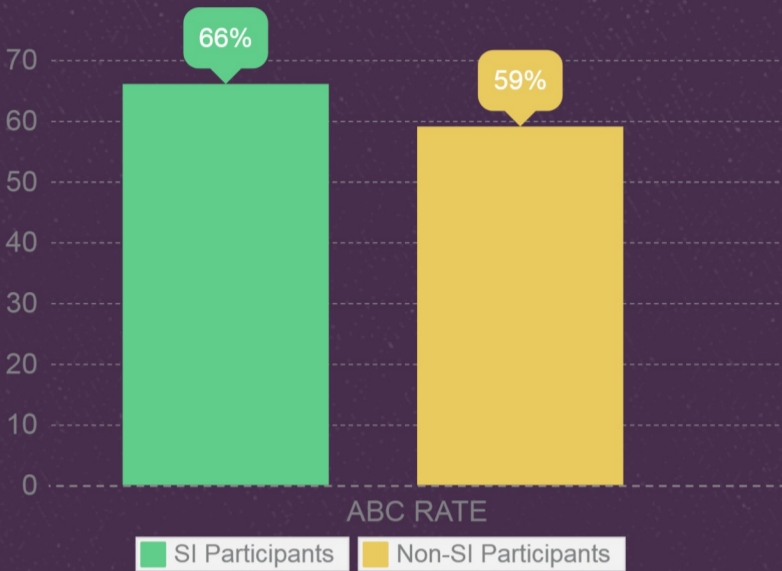


IMPACT OF SI ON GRADES SPRING 2016

OVERVIEW



In Spring 2016, the University of Houston-Downtown SI Program offered over 1,300 sessions with an average of 3 students attending per session.

Across all sections, 64% of students who attended SI came to sessions more than once.

The data above represents the percentage of withdrawals per group divided by the total number of students in SI sections who withdrew.

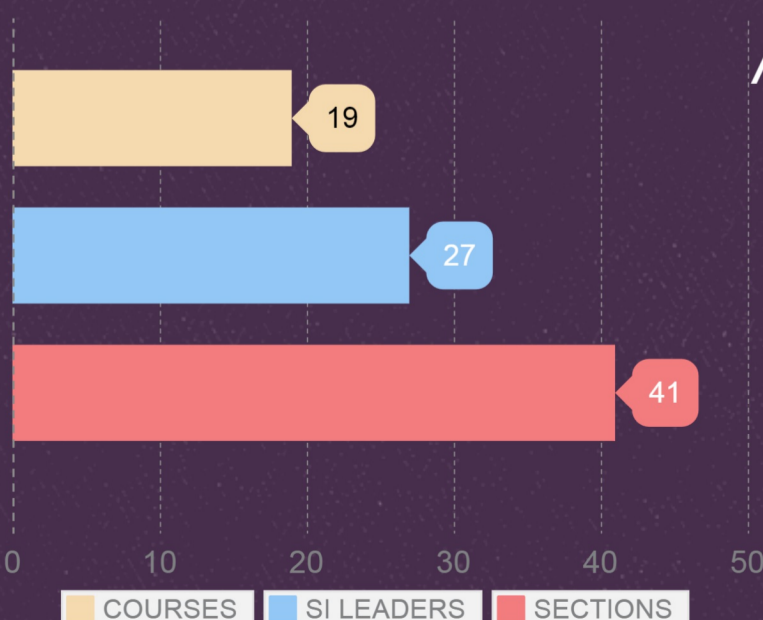
